Jewellery in School

I am writing to remind you that our policy concerning jewellery in school remains unchanged. Our simple rule is that our students are allowed to wear only a watch, no other forms of jewellery are permitted.

Some students are coming to school with earrings, bracelets, necklaces and rings. These will be confiscated and retained at school until you are able to collect them.

If you give your daughter/son permission for a piercing please ensure that this takes place at the start of the summer holidays. This will allow the necessary six week healing period. The piercings can then be safely and easily removed for school. Students are not allowed to wear earrings even if piercings are still healing.

If these simple rules are followed, it removes a potential source of conflict and enables us to focus on the more important matters relating to your child's education. I hope that we can look forward to your active cooperation in this matter.
